We are not the first to say this, but one thing that is constant is change. In our lifetimes we have seen the ways we communicate change by constant advances in technology. Our first phones required ringing up an operator! Radio, television (3 networks), computers, internet, streaming, social media, smart phones-it does not stop. Consequently, when change happens, it does affect those of us who are slow to adapt.

We have been blessed with a ministry of broadcasting our worship service for over 40 years. Being one of only a few such ministries, TRUMC has served thousands of people who could not attend live worship. The original model for our ministry, operated by church member volunteers, edited an onsite recording of our live service down to a half hour version for TV airing the following week. This was a good model for the state of technology in its time, along with the expertise of our TV ministry team.

Through conversation with our lay leadership, our core team chairs, and our current TV ministry team, we have considered the following impacts of changes in audio-video technology over these years:

- It is increasingly difficult to find people who have the interest, technical skills, and time commitment to handle this highly edited production adequately;
- ·other churches share broadcast ready services in ways that we cannot because they have multiple paid staff who are trained in production, editing, and communications
- -television is no longer the primary way that people participate in worship services from home, in part because the worship services broadcast on television are always a week delayed
- ·cable network viewership is declining at an alarming rate (including our broadcast) as more folks are comfortable with so many other methods to get their programming;
- the Covid years taught us that there are efficient ways to broadcast our live service (no need for time-consuming editing) and to then upload it to other apps for viewing via our web site; we intend to continue to share our worship services globally
- the current expense to air our edited taped services is very high at \$40,000 per year, a significant line item in our budget.

After weighing these many factors, the TRUMC Church Council has made the difficult decision not to renew our television contract with WACH-Fox as of December 31. We understand the disappointment that many loyal worship viewers will have and will do our best to guide them to our worship through means new to them. We will continue our live broadcasts on Facebook as well as uploading the services, on the same day, to our YouTube site.

This decision was made through prayer and careful deliberation by people who are long-time members and who love this church. Many decisions in all facets of life are difficult and painful but must be made as we move forward in changing times.

As we transition this beloved ministry to new technological methods of outreach, let us celebrate with gratitude the lives that have been enriched through the sharing of The Word. Be thankful, TRUMC, that God always makes a way and will empower us to continue and expand the reach of the vision born so many years ago!
