EXPLOSION OF FIRE

Back in my early years growing up in the countryside well beyond the city limits of the booming metropolis of Piedmont, SC, I was one of three boys to a newly divorced, single mom. We lived adjacent to Granny's 3-4 acre homestead and surrounded by hundreds of acres of farmland. The property that borders farmland is often generously filled with all kinds of vegetation from small saplings to briars to honeysuckle and blackberries. When it encroaches on your land, the only thing that you can do is cut it back. At that point, you either must haul it somewhere to take care of it or dispose of it in some way on your property. Not having a truck, my mom opted for option 2.

I can still remember the huge pile 7 - 8 feet high and a good 20 feet in diameter. To help encourage the disposal of the pile of brush, my mother liberally added kerosene. While she was placing the kerosene strategically around the brush pile, one of my younger brothers (who would have been five and seven at the time) found the matches. From some distance, I heard a sound I had not heard before. WOOOOOSSSSSHHHH! does not accurately capture the power and the violence of the explosion of that match hitting the kerosene. Fortunately, there was no more injury than some singed hairs and eyebrows. I learned to never underestimate the power of an explosion of fire.

As of May 28th, we are in the season of Pentecost. We celebrate another explosion of fire that took place in an upper room. The sound was described as a rushing, mighty wind that singed all those who were gathered in that room -- not their hair or eyebrows, but their hearts. That explosion of God's Holy Spirit was the birth of the church and has spread to change billions of lives.

We are in the season of Pentecost. We profess with our mouths the God's spirit is at work moving among the church now, as then. As we celebrate and worship and praise, as we discern God's call through small groups in Christian formation, as we capture God's vision for Trenholm Rd. UMC, we find ourselves playing with fire. So, hold on! Be ready! Do not underestimate the power of an explosion of the fire of the Holy Spirit.


Pulpit Swap
