Since her time with us nine years ago, she has been the lead pastor at St Paul UMC in Greenville, SC and at Lawrence Chapel UMC in Central, SC.

During our listening sessions and time of discernment last year, the church council identified four areas of focus including missions, hospitality/evangelism, small groups, and youth. The SPRC recognized that the first three of these areas offered an opportunity: if only we could find someone gifted by God, proven in ministry, and called to equip us to serve in these ways.

I believe that God's hand has been at work in delaying our request for an associate for a year while helping Mollie discern the call to serve with us once again.

For those who know Mollie from her time with us before, here is a word of caution: much has changed at Trenholm Road while she has been serving elsewhere AND God has been working in Mollie's life so that she, too, has changed and grown. Our time in ministry will not be like it was before.

For those who have never served alongside Mollie or experienced her leadership, we have much to look forward to. God is "doing a new thing! Now it springs up, do you not perceive it?" (Isaiah 43:19) I am grateful for the ways in which God's Spirit has been stirring among us here at Trenholm Road UMC and is calling us toward an exciting future of mission and ministry together.

We are pleased, honored and excited to welcome Rev. Dr. Susan Henry-Crowe to kick off a July study of the UMC Social Principles on Sunday, July 9 at 9am in the Dining Room. Rev. Henry-Crowe recently retired after serving 8 years as General Secretary of the General Board of Church and Society in Washington, DC. She'll be sharing with us from a lifetime of experience and leadership in promoting the Social Principles as a guide to how living into the Gospel can be expressed in our social interactions and institutions.

Rev Henry-Crowe is a member of the South Carolina Annual Conference, serving pastoral appointments in the upstate early in her career. For over 20 years she served as Dean of the Chapel of Religious Life at Emory University. Now, we welcome her back to SC as she shares with us her passion in advocating for social justice and peace.

On Sundays July 16, 23, 30 at 9am, small groups will meet in three classrooms in the main building to more deeply explore and discuss three individual UMC Social Principles: education, poverty, and human sexuality. Each topic will be discussed each Sunday allowing you to rotate between all three or choose the topics of most interest for the Sundays you're present.




Children's Sunday School for July and August
