
ONLINE SECURITY

The world of digital communication can be uncertain, and it's essential to be aware of the potential for scams, phishing, and fraud. At Trenholm Road United Methodist Church, we take the safety and security of our members seriously and want to remind you to be vigilant when it comes to online communication.

We have seen instances of scammers posing as Pastor James in emails, requesting gift cards or other payments. To reiterate, Pastor James will never ask you for any form of payment. We urge you not to respond to these emails, as they are not legitimate requests. If you ever have questions about a request for a gift card or other payment, don't hesitate to contact any staff member at TRUMC.

Additionally, please take the time to verify that the email address is actually affiliated with Pastor James or TRUMC. The email address will always appear as - (Staff member/group name @trumc.org). If it does not include trumc.org, it is a scam.

Never respond to emails that seem suspicious or ask for personal information. If you receive an email with a link or attachment from an unknown sender, it is best to delete it and not open it. Thank you for your attention, and stay safe!


