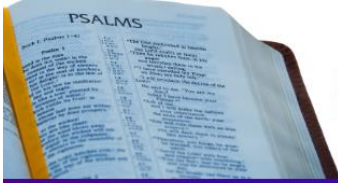

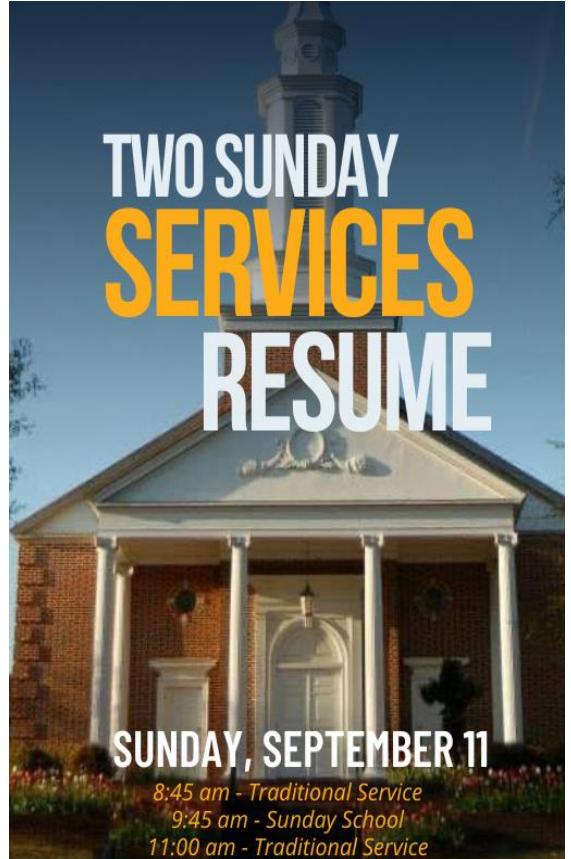

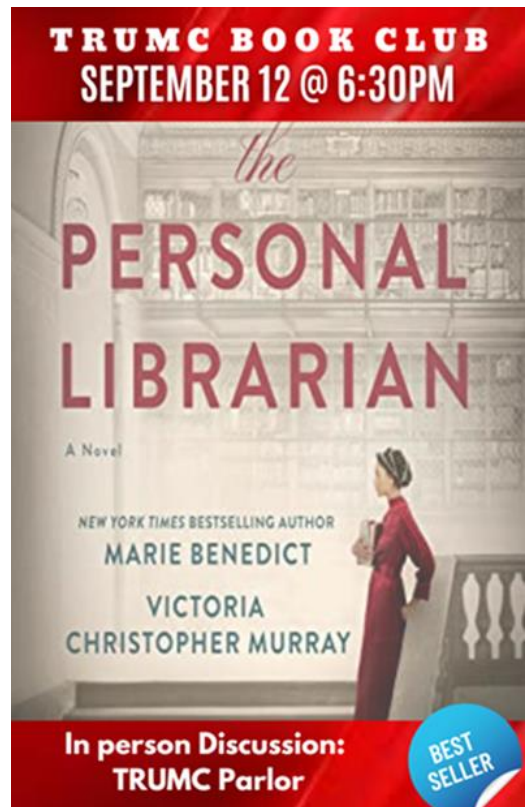
IN-PERSON Book Club returns
