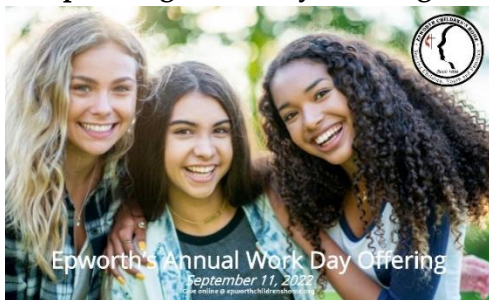

September 7-October 12*

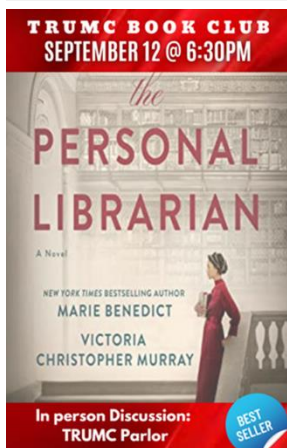
#### *Join in for weekly teaching, discussion and fellowship*
