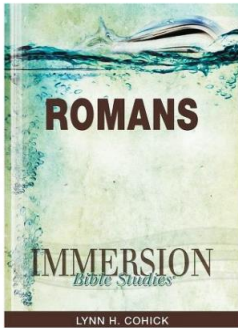

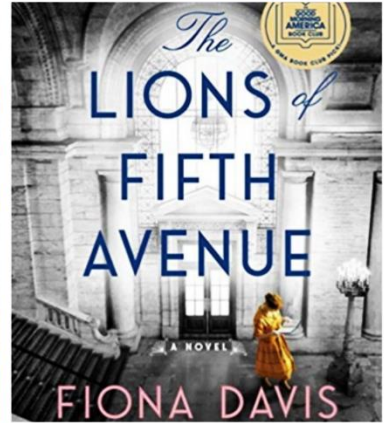
DELICIOUS CASSEROLES
