

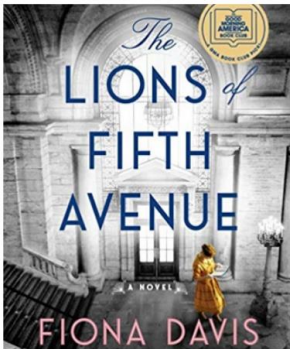

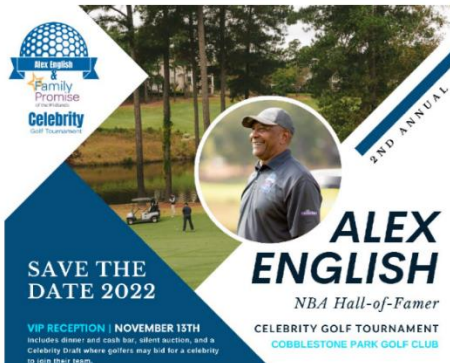
FAMILY PROMISE
