Welcome to Trenholm Road United Methodist Church!

We are so glad to have you here today. We want to make sure that everyone is comfortable during worship. Please note that there are restrooms located on the main hallway before entering the sanctuary. For your convenience, there is also a water fountain located in the West Foyer. While you're in the West Foyer Welcome Center, be sure to pick up a copy of our newsletter and devotionals.

Nursery care is available for children 6 weeks through 4 years old on Sunday mornings. Nursery care is available during all worship services and Sunday School times. Children under 2 are invited to stay in MB 19 and 2 years through 4 years in MB 12.

These rooms are on the bottom floor of the main building.

Two traditional worship services are held each Sunday at 8:45 AM and 11:00 AM. Sunday school class is at 9:45 AM on Sunday mornings.

All are welcome.

Each fall, we present the operating budget requirements for the coming year and offer everyone the opportunity to prayerfully choose to pledge support for that budget and the General Fund. Our stewardship is about recognizing God's work in our lives and responding to God with gratitude. Thank you for prayerfully sharing in the work of the ministry of Trenholm Road United Methodist Church.



8 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHY SHOULD YOU PLEDGE?

1 WHAT IS A PLEDGE?

A pledge is an estimate of giving; or a statement of intent. Pledging allows you to make a responsible and intentional decision about your financial giving to the church. When you plan ahead for your giving, you make conscious choices about spending your money in ways that reflect your faith and values. A tithe (10% of your income) has long been held as the standard of Christian giving.

3 DOES MY PLEDGE MATTER?

YES! The single largest source of funding for our ministries comes from our annual pledges.

Your annual pledge allows us to plan our

commitments to our staff and programs each year. All pledges of all amounts (small or large) are critical to help support a 2024 budget.

5 HOW DO I KEEP TRACK?

Your giving is recorded and a statement of your account is sent out each quarter. This not only keeps you advised of your giving, but also provides a document for your Federal Income Tax Return.

7 HOW DO I GET STARTED?

After prayer and consideration, pick up and fill out a pledge card located in the narthex, west foyer or Sunday School class. You may also use your mailed pledge card. Bring your pledge card with you to church on "Commitment Sunday" on Sunday, November 19. There will be a special time to offer your commitment to God during the worship service. Cards can also be mailed to the church.

2 WHERE DOES MY PLEDGE GO?

Receiving your pledge allows our TRUMC Council, the church's governing board, to do for our church what you do for your household: plan wisely for the use of our resources in support of the mission and ministry to which God has called us. Finance sets a budget based on the total amount pledged to the church. And while "weekly plate offerings" are important to the church, your pledge helps us more accurately plan for the future ministry we can accomplish together.

4 HOW CAN I PLEDGE?

You are welcome to give by cash, checks, credit cards via our secure on-line website, automatic checking drafts, and gifts of appreciated stock. Automated giving allows the church to receive your giving on a regular schedule. We know we can count on your offering being here and that helps us move forward confidently in our ministries. The church business office is happy to assist you with any of these options.

6 HOW DO I FULFILL MY PLEDGE?

You may pay weekly, monthly, quarterly, or even yearly via checks, cash or online giving. Determining the amount of your annual pledge is between you and God. Should life throw you a curve ball and you need to change your pledge, simply contact the church business office.

8 NEXT STEPS?

Simply - GIVE THANKS!

Start by sharing in your 2024 pledge commitment.
Your prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness will shape God's love for the world through the ministry of Trenholm Road United Methodist.
