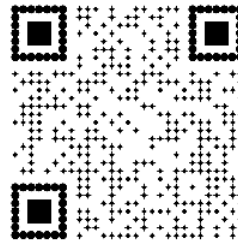
### Children's Updates

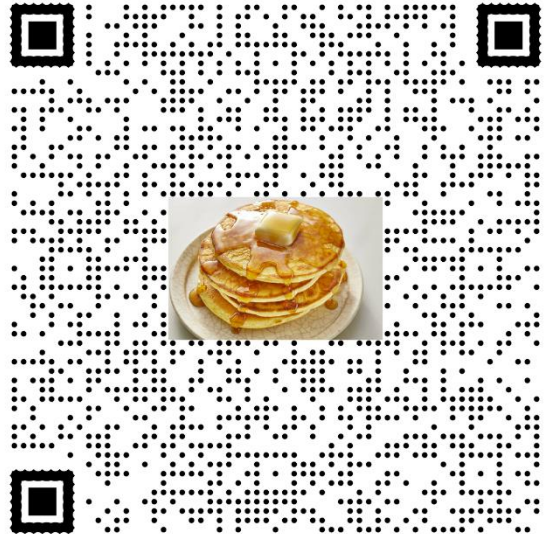
