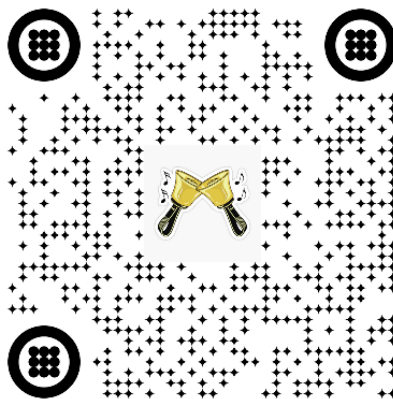

Family Promise "Host Week" Coming December 10-16

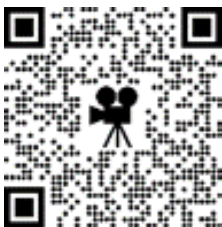

We are so glad to have you here today. We want to make sure that everyone is comfortable during worship. Please note that there are restrooms located on the main hallway before entering the sanctuary. For your convenience, there is also a water fountain located in the west foyer.

If your child is potty training or potty trained, please be sure to bring a change of clothes, just in case.
